# NTE Present's Preceptorship Program to become Certified Dietary Manager



### What are the Regulations?

The Federal requirements state, "For designations prior to November 28, 2016, meets the following requirements no later than 5 years after November 28, 2016, or no later than 1 year after November 28, 2016 for designations after November 28, 2016, is:"

- A certified dietary manager; A certified food service manager
- Has similar national certification for food service management and safety from a national certifying body
- Has an associate's or higher degree in food service management or in hospitality, if the course study includes food service or restaurant management, from an accredited institution of higher learning
- (ii) In States that have established standards for food service managers or dietary managers, meets State requirements for food service managers or dietary managers
- (iii) Receives frequently scheduled consultations from a qualified dietitian or other clinically qualified nutrition professional

### Who is a Qualified Director of Food and Nutrition Services/formerly known as a DSS?

- A <u>Certified Dietary Manager, Certified Food Protection Professional</u>
   (<u>CDM, CFPP</u>) has to pass a nationally-recognized credentialing exam
   offered by the Certifying Board for Dietary Managers.
- Continuing education is required to maintain these credentials
- CDM, CFPP credentials indicate that these individuals have the training and experience to competently perform the responsibilities of a dietary manager

## Is your Community's Director of Food and Nutrition Services qualified?

If not NTE Present's preceptorship to be certified Dietary Manager.

#### **RD Mentorship includes:**

- Teaching class from a RD (8 hours a month, 2 four hour classes)
- Help in navigating the assignments.
- RD evaluation of all the Assignment
- Reports on the student learning experiences to the UND instructor by reviewing and signing lessons and evaluation forms.
- Helps the student plan the experiences and projects.
- NTE will provide onsite 150 hours of field experiences
